MADISONVILLE – The Glema Mahr Center for the Arts has announced its 2025-2026 School Days Matinees lineup, featuring six events for students of all ages.

Lexington Children's Theatre opens the series in September with *Stuart Little* and *The Legend of Sleepy Hollow*. The traveling troupe will return in February with *The Princess Who Lost Her Hair* and *Pinocchio*. The series rounds out with the Hopkins County High Schools joint productions of *Godspell* in November and *Hello, Dolly!* in March.

"This might be my fa-

vorite series at the Glemma Center,” said Director Toby Roberts. “We know how important it is. The programming caters to students starting in kindergarten and follows them through high school graduation. It is frequently the first time—and may be the only time—some of them will have a live arts experience. Our hope is to foster a love of the arts that will last their entire lives.”
