Flannery to strengthen DUI laws passes

Last week, the House Standing Committee on Judiciary passed HB 456. The measure, sponsored by State Representative Patrick Flannery of Olive Hill, is aimed at strengthening Kentucky's laws on driving under the influence (DUI). The measure would enhance DUI enforcement and penalties, ensuring greater accountability and safety on roadways.

"HB 456 is about protecting families and making our roads safer," Flannery said. strengthening penalties and ensuring consis-

tent enforcement, we are takpaired driving and its devastating consequences."

HB 456 proposes several key provisions, including toughening fentanyl and drugged driving penalties for repeat offenders, and requirements for ignition interlock devices. The measure would also clarify testing protocols and enhance legal consequences for aggravated circumstances, such as excessive speeding, driving the wrong way on highways, and DUI incidents resulting in serious injury or death.

"As lawmakers, our priority ing a firm stand against im- is to keep Kentuckians safe, this bill does just that," Flannery added. "I appreciate my colleagues for recognizing the importance of this measure and moving it forward in the legislative process."

The measure also provides necessary flexibility for those convicted of DUI by establishing clear procedures for ignition interlock licenses while maintaining struct oversight to prevent repeat offenses.

So let's try to develop an attitude of acceptance toward other Christians.

ety becomes more evil, people are becoming bolder in their rejection of God and Christianity. As many church leaders have pointed out in the past few years, the church no longer enjoys home field advantage. The church in the United States has more enemies in their own community than ever before.

So, how will we treat these enemies? Jesus says to love them (Matthew 5:43-48). This does not mean that we agree with them. It means that we express our disagreement as kindly and as lovingly as we can. We may never win some of them over, but we won't win them over with hatred—that's for sure.


