A street legal special purpose vehicle must be inspected by a certified inspector in the Lewis County Sheriff's Office.

A person operating a street-legal special purpose vehicle under this ordinance must comply with all applicable traffic regulations.

Harrison read that "street-legal special purpose vehicles shall be allowed on all highways that are located within the jurisdictional limits of Lewis County. For the purposes of this ordinance, streets in the City of Vanceburg are excluded."

The City of Vanceburg has established its own requirements for operation of such vehicles on city streets.

Harrison also spelled out exceptions in the proposal.

Street-legal special purpose vehicles shall not be allowed to operate:

- On any highway, or portion thereof, located within the jurisdictional limits of

Lewis County unless permitted by this ordinance.

- On any highway, or portion thereof, that is operating as a school zone during pick up and or drop off hours.
- On any highway, or portion thereof, that is owned by or being operated by Lewis County Schools, including but not limited to Garrison Elementary, Central Elementary, Laurel Elementary, Tollesboro Elementary, Lewis County Middle School, or Lewis County High School.
- On any highway, or portion thereof, that is a controlled access system, including but not limited to an interstate or parkway; or
- On any highway, or portion thereof, where the United States Department of Agriculture prohibits special purpose vehicles.

There are also prohibitions implemented in the proposal.

- Street-legal special purpose vehicles are prohibited from traveling a distance greater than twenty (20) miles on a highway displaying centerline pavement markings.
- Minitrucks shall not be operated as street-legal special purpose vehicles on a highway that has been constructed pursuant to a federal highway program.

If approved on the second reading, expected during the regular June meeting of fiscal court, the ordinance would become effective locally on July 1 and upon publication in THE HERALD.
