Although impaired driving enforcement is a yearround effort, crashes tend to increase over holiday weekends. That's why the Kentucky Office of Highway Safety (KOHS) is joining the National Highway Traffic Administration Safety (NHTSA) and law enforcement agencies across the country in the "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" campaign, which runs from Aug. 13 through Sept. 1, 2025.

"It is never acceptable to drive impaired," said Kentucky Transport Cabinet (KYTC) Secretary Jim Gray. "Alcohol, drugs and even prescription medications can impair your ability to operate a vehicle safely. You may feel 'OK,' but impairment slows your judgment, coordination and reaction time."
