County Clerk Randy Williams told the Courier that no additional people have filed to run for local offices since the publication of last week's candidate listing.

In state offices, Democrat Iva Markicevic Daley, who resides in Sandy Hook, has filed to run for state representative in the 99th District – a seat currently held by Republican Richard White, of Morehead.

Daley and White are the only candidates for that office at press time.

In federal offices, Democrat Pamela Stevenson and Republican George Washington have filed for the office of U.S. Senator, both joining multiple other candidates on their parties' ballots.
