United Way celebrates community impact

PADUCAH — The United Way of Western Kentucky raised money to aid area nonprofits and honored people who've made a difference in the community Friday during its annual Victory Celebration.

Held in partnership with the Fred Paxton Challenge for Charities, the celebration at the Walker Hall Event Center in Paducah included the drawing for the United Way's Jackpot Raffle. The winner of this year's \$5,000 raffle prize was Berneice Willis. While there can only be one prize winner, every \$50 raffle ticket sold benefits local agencies working to improve education, income and health in west Kentucky.

In its 2024-2025 year, the United Way of Western Kentucky said donors to the organization had a financial impact of more than \$1.46 million, including more than \$1 million in United Way campaign donations, \$358,417 for disaster relief, \$60,996 in grant support, \$30,562 in in-kind donations and \$10,000 endowment gifts. United Way campaign support provided 39,383 services in the region across the organization's many partner agencies.

In celebration of those efforts, awards were presented to honor individuals and businesses making a difference in the community through contributions to the United Way.
