City of Stanton, Kentucky Ordinance No. 25-001 An Ordinance Relating to the Imposition of a License Fee for Engaging in Business in the City of Stanton; Requiring for the Payment of said Fees; and the Imposition of Penalties for Violation of the Provisions of this Ordinance

Summary of Ordinance

The City of Stanton has recently passed an Ordinance designating license fees for those lividuals or legal entities engaging in business within the City limits of Stanton, Kentucky The Ordinance bases the amount of license fee upon the type of business being conducted. The Ordinance also, in certain situations, further differentiates within each business class based upon

Section 1. <u>Imposition of License Fee and on Whom Imposed.</u>

the type of services provided, the number of units, and other criteria

There is hereby levied and imposed a license fee upon all persons, firms, corporations, limited partnerships, partnerships or other legal entities, (except an "employee" - as defined herein), engaged in any occupation, trade, or profession in the City of Stanton, Kentucky, for the privilege of engaging in such occupation, trade, or profession inside the City limits of Stanton, Kentucky. For the purposes of this Ordinance the term "person" shall hereafter mean "any person, firm, corporation, limited partnership, partnership or other legal entity which is engaged in or which conducts business or sells or offers for sale any article of goods, wares or merchandise or provides or offers to provide services for gain or profit, within the city limits of

It shall be unlawful for any person or legal entity, (except an employee, as defined It shall be unlawful for any person or legal entity, (except an employee, as defined herein), regardless of whether or not such person or legal entity maintains a place of business within the corporate limits of the city of Stanton, to engage in any business, occupation, trade or profession, or to sell, or offer for sale, any article of goods, wares or merchandise or to provide or offer to provide any service for gain or profit, within the corporate limits of the City of Stanton, Kentucky without first having obtained and secured a business license from the City of Stanton and paid the required license fee as set forth herein. The particular fee for each type of business is set forth in Section 7 of this Ordinance

Section 2 of the Ordinance clarifies that the Ordinance is not applicable to "employees" and defines "employees" as it relates to the Ordinance

Section ${\bf 3}$ of the Ordinance details the process in order to apply for a business license.

Section 4. Payment of License Fee.

Each person or legal entity engaged in business inside the city limits of the City of Stanton shall pay on or before August $1^{\rm st}$ of each year a license fee based on that attached Standow Standing of the privilege of engaging in business inside the city limits of Stanton, Kentucky. Payment shall be made to the Stanton City Clerk at the Stanton City Hall during regular business hours on or before August 1th of each year. The term of said license shall be from August 1th of each year until July 31th of the following year. Failure to pay said license fee or fees shall result in penalties and interest pursuant to Section 8 of this Ordinance, as well as the imposition of criminal penalties pursuant to Section 9 of this Ordinance.

Section 5 of the Ordinance deals with Temporary or Pro-rated License Fees for those businesses which commence business sometime after August 1st of this year or which conduct business on a periodic basis.
