Raney often hurt the Panthers on quarterback keeper plays, while Redmon used his size to power through for a handful of first-down rushes.

Meade County had a late opportunity in the first half for a chip-shot field goal, but with no timeouts left and 10 seconds to go, the Green Waves couldn't get their special teams unit on in time.

The Panthers turned momentum their way for good early in the third quarter. Sophomore quarterback Ethan Shelton hit wideout Jace Hagy for a 35-yard gain to set up a bruising

6-yard scoring run from tailback Darian Bryant, putting Elizabethtown on top, 12-7, after a failed two-point conversion.

Meade County had its chance to swing back late in the third, driving inside the Panther 25-yard line behind a 39-yard rush from Redmon. But a 34-yard field goal attempt sailed left, leaving the Green Wave empty-handed.

Elizabethtown capitalized with a steady, clock-chewing drive in the fourth quarter. Shelton connected with receiver Zechariah Williamson on a 15-yard touchdown strike in the back corner of the end zone, stretching the lead to 18-7 with four minutes remaining.

From there, the Panther

defense closed it out. Bryant and Chance McCarty each recorded sacks on Meade County's final possession, ending any hopes of a rally.

Elizabethtown will carry its momentum into next week with a 3-1 mark, hosting Nelson County at 7:30 p.m. in a Class 4A District 2 matchup.

"We start district play next week, so this win was huge for our young team, mentally and emotionally," Mattingly said.

The Green Waves continue their search for the win column on the road Friday at 7:30 p.m. against Collins.

Meade County coach Blake Powers was not available for a post-game interview.

have their highest ranking since they were No. 10 entering November last season.

Notre Dame has lost its first two games, both against ranked opponents, by a total of four points. The Irish lost 27-24 at Miami and had an open date before Texas A&M visited. They fell from No. 8 to No. 24. The 1988 Michigan Wolverines, the previous team to start 0-2 and remain ranked, also had an extremely tough first two games. They entered the season No. 9 and lost to No. 13 Notre Dame 19-17, dropped to No. 15 and lost 31-30 at No. 1 Miami. Michigan was No. 19 the following week and went 9-0-1 the rest of the way.

Other teams that started 0-2 and stayed in the rankings were 1984 Auburn, 1958 SMU, 1949 Missouri and 1948 Purdue.

### IN AND OUT

Georgia Tech, coming off its win over Clemson, is 3-0 for the first time since 2016, and its No. 18 ranking is its highest since 2015.

No. 20 Vanderbilt's 24-point win at South Carolina earned the Commodores their highest ranking since they started 5-0 in 2008.

No. 25 USC has its first ranking since the first week of last October.

South Carolina (11), Clemson (12) and South Florida (18) are out.

The Gamecocks were down 14-7 late in the first half when quarterback LaNorris Sellers

was knocked out of the game with a concussion. Clemson, ranked No. 4 in the pre-season, hasn't been 1-2 since 2014.

South Florida's weeklong stay in the Top 25 ended with its 49-12 loss at Miami.

-were significant chants of "Crawford" in the bout's later rounds, and even Canelo backers didn't try to boo them down as they had earlier in the night.

This was the first defeat for Alvarez (63-3-2, 39 KOs), the 35-year-old champion from Mexico who looked like the older boxer even going against someone his junior, since losing by unanimous decision to Dmitri Bivol on May, 7, 2022. He was the -185 favorite at BetMGM Sportsbook.

"We knew Crawford is a great fighter," Alvarez said. "I did what I was supposed to do. I trained really hard.

He deserved all the credit. I tried my best tonight and I couldn't figure out the style. "He had everything."

This fight already was being compared with some of the greatest in Las Vegas' rich history well before the two contestants tapped gloves.

The setting of Allegiant Stadium itself separated this bout because it was the first

match at this venue. Never in question was the attendance record for a Las Vegas fight — 29,214 in 1982 for heavyweight champion Larry Holmes' 13th-round knockout of Gerry Cooney at Caesars Palace's specially constructed outdoor stadium — would fall on this night. So did the gate gross revenue record, the fight making \$47.23 million.
