## All flood recovery contractors to register with county

The Pike County Fiscal Court approved an executive order to be signed by Judge-Executive Ray S. Jones requiring all contractors for both commercial and residential flood recovery projects to register with the county.

Jones said the order is based on a document he received from the Kentucky Attorney General's Consumer Protection Program. The purpose of having contractors register with the county Occupational Tax Office is to prevent "fly-by-night" contractors from preying on

# PFD issues annual activity report

The Pikeville Fire Department presented its annual activity report for 2024 to the Pikeville City Commission during its March 10.

The presentation was delayed because of the February flood event.

According to the report, PFD responded to 2,329 total fire-related calls.

Of those 2,329 calls, Station 1 responded to 1,480 calls, Station 2

responded to 341 calls and Station 3 responded to 495 calls.

Fire-related calls include brush/ forest fires, gas emergencies, mutual aid and vehicle fires among others.

Only three structure fires were reported in 2024.

The annual report also includes calls for Emergency Medical Services to which PFD responded to 2,136 calls for EMS/ambulance.


