1. Introduction

Pike County Health Department is seeking proposals from qualified vendors to digitize all paper patient files, upload the scanned documents to a secure server, and prepare import files compatible with our Electronic Medical Records (EMR) system.

2. Project Overview

The goal of this project is to create an efficient and secure digital archive for patient records while ensuring that the data is properly formatted and integrated into our existing EMR system. This includes:

- Scanning of paper patient files
- Uploading scanned files to a secure server
- Providing off-site storage during the digitization process
- · Organizing scanned files in an easily accessible and searchable manner
- Preparing and converting files into the required format for EMR system import
