NOTICE OF ENACTMENT AND SUMMARY OF RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY

LEGALS

OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY RELATING TO THE AUTHORIZATION AND ISSUANCE OF THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES (UNIVERSITY OF PIKEVILLE - COLLEGE OF DENTAL MEDICINE) SERIES 2025.

Said Resolution:

A. Authorizes and approves the issuance of by the City of Pikeville, Kentucky (the "City") of its City of Pikeville, Kentucky Educational Facilities Revenue Bond Anticipation Notes (University of Pikeville - College of Dental Medicine), Series 2025 (the "Notes") in an amount not to exceed \$55,000,000, issued as fully registered notes, which may be exchanged for and/or reissued, as more fully provided for in the Indenture (hereinafter identified).

B. The Notes shall bear interest from the date of their delivery, at such rate and shall be payable in such amounts and at such times as specified in the Note Purchase Agreement (the "Note Purchase Agreement"), all as agreed upon by the City, the University of Pikeville, Inc. (the "University") and Raymond James & Associates, Inc. (the "Underwriter"), pursuant to Section 103.230 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes; provided, however, that the maximum rate of interest on the Notes shall not exceed seven percent (7%) per annum.

C. Authorizes the Mayor to execute a Loan Agreement by and between the City and the University and to execute all necessary documents, instruments and obligations of the City in order to aid the University in providing interim financing to pay the costs of constructing and equipping a new 102,000 square foot, six-story/five floor educational facility to be located on the campus of the University to house the University's College of Dental Medicine (the "Project").

D. Authorizes the Mayor to execute a Trust Indenture (the "Indenture") by and between the City and U.S. Bank, National Association, as Trustee (the "Trustee") for the Notes.

E. Authorizes the Mayor to execute the Note Purchase Agreement providing

for the sale of the Notes at the aggregate price and pursuant to the terms and interest rate stated therein.

F. Authorizes and approves of the distribution of a Preliminary Official Statement by the Underwriter to market the Notes.

ORDINANCE RELATING TO INDOOR/OUTDOOR TOURISM AND FESTIVALS WITHIN ELKHORN CITY, KENTUCKY

Ordinance No. 2018-001

WHEREAS, the Elkhorn City Council has determined a need for regulation for Indoor/Outdoor music and festivals within the City of Elkhorn City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ELKHORN CITY that the City of Elkhorn City does hereby establish the following regulations for Indoor/Outdoor Music and festivals in Elkhorn City, Kentucky.

All person wanting to have an event/festival in Elkhorn City shall obtain a permit from the City Clerk or Chief of Police.

Fees for said permit shall be as follows;

Single Event \$50.00 Per Day
Non Profits shall pay no fee but must complete the permit application

Outdoor music during permitted events and series of event shall cease at the following times.

Sunday- Saturday 10:00 a.m.-Midnight
Holidays 10:00 a.m.- Midnight

Permit holder is subject to local, state and federal laws as well as city ordinances. All events must follow Chapter 117 Amusement Ordinance.

Without approved permit from City Clerk or Chief of Police event will not be permitted and is subject to cessation.

This ordinance shall be amended and in full force and effect after it is passed and published as required by law. This ordinance was given a first reading on August 21, 2025. C. Effective Date of Ordinance Provisions

The Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its Passage and Publications as required by law.
