admission to Hanover College in 1948, as a transfer student from Indiana University. She lived in Madison while attending Hanover College.

According to Madison historian Sue Livers, whose aunt was Saunders’ sister, there was some opposition to integration among the Hanover College board of trustees, but there was also support from other campus leaders. Katharine McAfee Parker, wife of Hanover College President Albert Parker (1929-1958), helped Saunders secure funds from alumni to continue her education at Hanover College.

Saunders graduated with a bachelors degree in Sociology and Political Science and went on to earn a masters degree in education at Kent State

University and a masters in Psychology at Akron University.

She dedicated her life to improving the world through education and community involvement, and was committed to Civil Rights, which included marching in Washington D.C.

Saunders lived in Washington D.C. and Natick, Massachusetts, from 1951-53. She married Edward Saunders, an architect, Aug. 21, 1953, and they were married 15 years until his death, Nov. 10, 1968. The couple had two children, including a daughter, Stacey Prince Saunders, and a son, Marc Saunders.

Saunders enjoyed a lengthy career as an educator, teaching in Akron, Ohio, and Anchorage, Alaska, from 1958 until her retirement in 1997. She worked from 1958-81 as a teacher in the Akron public school system at Lane, David Hill,

Hatton, Fairlawn and Windemere elementary schools and Thornton Junior High School.

She moved to Alaska in 1982, teaching at Chu-giak (Alaska) Elementary School from 1983-97. Saunders died March 19, 2009, of stroke and diabetes complications at Providence Alaska Medical Center in Anchorage.

Gene’s favorite hobbies were playing the piano, reading, writing poetry, modern art, science, discussing politics, gardening, playing golf and viewing nature, especially mountains and wildlife. She also loved dogs.

The oil-on-canvas painting, created by Houston artist and educator Eddie Filer Jr., features Saunders, wearing a green dress adorned with a pearl necklace, seated in a red leather chair with a nearby flower-filled vase. The painting was commissioned by Lisa Fleming, a 1982

Hanover College graduate who is a retired attorney and member of Hanover’s Board of Trustees.

upgrading the HVAC system at the courthouse and installing solar panels there and on other buildings as well as new water treatment equipment at the jail.

Carroll County Attorney Nick Marsh voiced concern that the scale of the project might require that the work be advertised for competitive bids, but since Ascendant is under a general procurement contract with the state to provide services at an agreed upon competitive rate that may not be the case. However, since no work can currently begin until the weather improves, the court agreed to table a decision and provide time for that issue to be clarified.

Among other department reports, the court:

- Heard a report on the county’s indoor pool at Kysoc Park that hours will be adjusted to provide more evening opportunities. The pool hours will now be open from 9 a.m. to noon on weekdays and 10 a.m. to noon on Saturdays as well as 5:30 p.m. to 9 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays. - Carroll County Emergency Services and EMS Director Tony Crutcher said the Automated External Defibrillators (AED) the county ordered have been received, are in the process of being installed in government buildings and should be put in service in February. He

noted that EMS is offering CPR and AED training to any county employee who wants to develop those life saving skills.

- Now that there has been a break in the inclement weather, the new Americans with Disabilities Act playground equipment purchased for Kysoc Park will

soon begin installation. Although the project has been delayed one of the positives of that delay is that the entire area will now be covered with a safer rubberized surface rather than part of the surface being wood mulch as proposed earlier.
