Having direct contact with someone with norovirus.

Eating food or drinking liquids contaminated with norovirus.

Touching contaminated objects or surfaces and then putting your unwashed fingers in your mouth.

Norovirus is most contagious when you are feeling sick, and even for a few days after you are feeling better.
