

AN AMENDED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEAVER DAM, KENTUCKY, ESTABLISHING AN INCREASE IN THE RATE FOR THE COLLECTION OF TRASH, GARBAGE AND REFUSE FROM RESIDENTIAL DWELLINGS, MULTI-FAMILY DWELLINGS, APARTMENT COMPLEXES AND TRAILER PARKS LOCATED IN & OUT OF THE CORPORATE CITY LIMITS.

ORDINANCE #062325-3

WHEREAS, in Ordinance Number 122920-2, the City passed an ordinance which established the procedure and fixed the rate for the collection of trash, garbage and refuse from residential dwellings located within the corporate city limits of the city, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Commission of the City of Beaver Dam, Kentucky, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Each person who resides in a residential dwelling within the corporate city limits and who receives water services and a water bill in his name shall be charged and assessed \$14.00 for intown rate; \$16.00 for out-of-town rate and \$22.50 for business/commercial rate per month for collection and disposal of trash, garbage and refuse by the city. There is now an option for 6 extra bags of trash a week for an additional \$6 a month, a monthly total fee of \$20 for in-town rate, \$22 for out-of-town rate and \$28.50 for business/commercial rate per month. This option for additional trash pick-up will last a calendar year for customers that sign up for this option. The charge shall be added to each customer's water bill and shall be paid simultaneously with the payment for water services. All customers who fail or refuse to pay any monthly garbage collection charge shall be assessed a penalty in the sum of 10% per month.

SECTION II: Each owner of a multi-family dwelling, apartment complex or trailer park who requests the city to undertake the collection of trash, garbage or refuse from the residential unites located on his/ her property shall be charged and assessed \$14.00 in-town; \$16.00 for out-of-town per unit and \$22.50 for business/commercial per month for the collection and disposal of trash, garbage and refuse by the city. There is now an option for 6 extra bags of trash a week for an additional \$6 a month, a monthly total fee of \$20 for in-town rate; \$22 for out-of-town rate and \$28.50 for business/commercial rate per month. This option for additional trash pick-up will last a calendar year for customers that sign up for this option. The charge shall be added to each customer's water bill and shall be paid simultaneously with the payment for water services. All customers who fail or refuse to pay any monthly garbage collection charge shall be assessed a penalty in the sum of 10% per month.


