

New operation in Bell County with \$2.1 Million Investment, creating 37 New Jobs

Thursday April 24, 2025 - Gov. Andy Beshear announced an exciting project within the state's manufacturing industry as E & E Hardwoods Inc., a full-grade sawmill operation supporting the local logging industry and lumber production industry, plans to add 37 new jobs and invest \$2.1

million to expand its Bell County operation following a December 2024 fire that destroyed the company's previous location.

"Kentucky has always been home to some of the hardest-working and most resilient people I have ever met. When tragedy strikes or obstacles come our way, Kentuckians don't blink," said Gov. Beshear. "E & E Hardwoods' leadership wasted no time getting back on their feet, rebuilding less than six months after losing the business in a fire. E & E Hardwoods is rebuilding and expanding its Bell County operation by relocating to a larger, more advanced building. The 30,000-square-foot facility will help accommodate the company's growth, increase capabilities and improve

operations. The \$2.1 million investment is expected to create 37 jobs for the Bell County community and surrounding areas.
