

Indictments issued by Bullitt Grand Jury

SHEPHERDSVILLE – A man has been indicted for causing injuries to another individual by use of a motor vehicle while under the influence.

The Bullitt County Grand Jury recently handed down indictments for felony charges against a number of individuals.

Those charged include:
*Michael White – charged with assault.

According to the indictment, White was allegedly operating under the influence when he engaged in conduct that put another individual in grave risk of serious physical injury on Oct. 2, 2025.

This is a Class B felony, which is punishable by 10-20 years in prison.

Bullitt County Sheriff's Deputy Scott Mattingly investigated the case.

*Clarissa Marie Smith – charged with burglary.

The indictment alleges that on July 25, 2018, Smith was charged with entering a building on Senate Lane in Mount Washington. She was armed with explosives or deadly weapons.

This is a Class B felony, punishable by 10-20 years in prison.

Det. Evan Brown of the Mount Washington Police Department investigated.

*Bronson Derek Byrd – charged with complicity to burglary.

According to the indictment, Byrd acted with Smith in committing a burglary on July 25, 2018. He also had the intent to commit a crime in complicity with another individual and one of the two participants were in possession of explosives or deadly weapons.

This is also a Class B felony and Brown investigated.

*Robert Eugene Vance – charged with three counts of possession of a controlled substance, possession of marijuana and promoting contraband.

The indictment alleges that on Oct. 3, 2025, Vance had marijuana, methamphetamine and an unspecified drug in his possession with the intent to sell. He was also in the possession of a firearm.

He also tried to bring contraband into the Bullitt County Detention Center.

The most serious offense is a Class C felony, which is punishable by 5-10 years in prison.

Deputy sheriff Braxton Faith of the Bullitt County Sheriff's Office investigated.

*D'Varie Robinson – charged with unlawful access to a computer.

The indictment alleges that on Sept. 4, 2025, Robinson gained access to a computer without the permission of the owner.

This is a Class C felony, punishable by 5-10 years in prison.

Brown was the investigating officer.

*Susan Jackson – charged with assault.

The indictment alleges that on Aug. 13, 2025, Jackson caused serious injury to another individual with a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument.

This is a Class C felony, which would result in a prison sentence of 5-10 years.

Shepherdsville officer Jonathan Greer investigated.

*Edward Ford – charged with robbery.

According to the indictment, on Sept. 4, 2025, Ford allegedly used physical force to commit a robbery of an individual.

This is a Class C felony. Mattingly investigated the case.

*Brian M. Broderick – charged with sexual abuse.

According to the indictment, Broderick touched a person under 12 years of age on Sept. 29, 2025.

The offense is a Class C felony, punishable by 5-10 years.

KSP trooper Jacob Farmer investigated.

*Nicholas Hunter Jacobsen – charged with five counts of promoting contraband.

The indictment alleges that on Sept. 30, 2025, Jacobsen tried to take illegal contraband into the Bullitt County Detention Center.

These are Class D felonies, each punishable by 1-5 years in prison.

*Domanique N. Frazier – charged with two counts of wanton endangerment.

The indictment alleges that on Aug. 2, 2025, Frazier

engaged in conduct that put two individuals in risk of serious injury.

This is a Class D felony, punishable by 1-5 years in prison.

Shepherdsville officer Steven Martin investigated.

*Kenneth P. Duvall – charged with possession of a controlled substance.

The indictment alleges that on July 11, 2025, Duvall had

methamphetamine in his possession.

This is a Class D felony, punishable by 1-3 years in prison.

Bullitt County deputy sheriff Daniel Embry investigated.

*Christopher C. Burton – charged with assault.

According to the indictment, on Aug. 9, 2025, Burton allegedly caused or attempted to cause injury to a police

officer.

This is a Class D felony, punishable by 1-5 years in prison.

Hillview Sgt. Jeremy Davis investigated.

*Mark Anthony Boggs – charged with being a persistent felony offender.

The indictment alleges that Boggs was convicted for four

prior felony offenses and any new sentence could be enhanced.

An indictment does not mean guilt or innocence.


Instead, it means that at least nine of the 12 grand jurors felt there was enough evidence to move forward with a criminal proceeding.
