ORDINANCE NO. 25-12 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, KENTUCKY ENACTING ABANDONED AND VACANT PROPERTY REGISTRATION PROVISIONS

By Ordinance No. 25-12, the Board of Commissioners for the City of Richmond, Kentucky create zoning regulations which apply to vacant and abandoned properties in the downtown historical district. These regulations require registration of vacant and abandoned properties and impose an escalating fine structure for vacant and abandoned properties based upon the length of the vacancy.

ORDINANCE NO. 25-13 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, KENTUCKY AMENDING ORDINANCE 14-24 REGULATING SMOKING

By Ordinance No. 25-13, the Board of Commissioners for the City of Richmond, Kentucky amend zoning regulations which apply to retail tobacco stores. This amendment allows a for smoking in any establishment which shall qualify as a retail tobacco store by generating greater than fourty (40) percent of annual gross local sales from the sale of leaf tobacco products and accessories. Online sales shall not count as local sales. Any establishment claiming retail tobacco store status shall be subject to random audits by the City of Richmond.

ORDINANCE NO. 25-14 AN ORDINANCE PROMOTING PUBLIC HEALTH IN THE REQUIREMENT OF CERTIFICATION OF RECOVERY RESIDENCES PROVIDING HOUSING FOR INDIVIDUALS IN RECOVERY FROM SUBSTANCE USE

Ordinance No. 25-14 of the City of Richmond establishes requirements for the certification and operation of recovery residences (sober living homes) within city limits. It mandates that, beginning after May 27, 2025, all such residences must be certified by a recognized organization and register proof with the City. The ordinance gives the Code Enforcement Board authority to enforce compliance, issue penalties, and pursue legal action against uncertified operators. It aligns with KRS 222.500-222.510, enabling oversight to protect vulnerable individuals in recovery, promote public health, and prevent abuse in unregulated sober living environments.
