

Kentucky to award \$5 million in grants for opioid research projects

The Kentucky Opioid Abatement Advisory Commission will award \$5 million in grant money for research projects and “innovative approaches to developing and implementing effective novel therapeutic interventions” for opioid use disorder and treating substance use

disorder. Applications for the \$5 million will open July 1 and will close Dec. 20, Attorney General Russell Coleman’s office announced Monday, June 9. Winners will be decided next March or April. Eligible applicants are nonprofit and for-profit entities that have good standing with the Secretary of State and government entities.

“So much good work is being done to transform lives in our commonwealth thanks to more than \$85 million in opioid abatement funds already distributed,” Chris Evans, the executive director of the commission, said in a statement. “This \$5 million is meant to push us further in our ability to innovate




