As children are home from school for the Christmas break,

there are plenty of opportunities for parents to feel real struggles of getting worn down from the additional cooking, cleaning, children begging to be with their friends, and being worn down and easily frustrated from late nights and sugar highs.

What we tend to overlook as parents is that these two weeks are not only temporary, but also often overlook the truths that this is a perfect time for building relationships and connecting with our children.

While we may not need to agree with all request our children will plea for during this two-week hiatus, most of us can agree that when we were school aged we too counted the days for

a two-week vacation of zero routine.

Letting our children know we can remember how this time away from school was also once special to us can open up doors for communication about what can be agreed on to allow your child their fun desired and parents relaxation required.

I encourage parents to not feel the need to plan out everyday of the two weeks ahead of time. Instead, leave some wiggle room. Take the opportunity to sit down with your child every few days throughout this break to discuss plans.

Planning only a few days in advance can give the child a sense of hope that their needs are validated while allowing you as the

parent a sense of control without coming across as controlling. Being open to their request doesn't mean you have lost control, but it can mean a lot to your children when witnessing that you see them as a valuable part of the family and that you understand they deserve a break too.

AN ORDINANCE regulating Electrical Inspection Fees.

SECTION ONE - RESIDENTIAL FEE SCHEDULE
RESIDENTIAL INSPECTION FEE SCHEDULE

Single Family Dwelling (SFD)	\$75.00 per inspection
Multi Family Dwelling (MFD)	\$75.00 per meter
Mobile Homes	\$75.00
Additions	\$75.00
Change Outs	\$75.00
Re-Inspection	\$75.00

SECTION TWO - COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL FEE SCHEDULE
COMMERCIAL INSPECTION FEE SCHEDULE

Fees for State Inspections.

- The electrical contractor, property owner, or other person responsible for the electrical work shall pay the department the inspection fee required by this section.
- A certificate of inspection or other final approval of an electrical construction, installation, alteration, or repair shall not be issued by the department until the fee required by this subsection has been paid.
- The fee to inspect electrical work having a complete value of less than \$8,000 shall be \$125.
- The fee to inspect electrical work having a complete value more than \$8,000 but less than \$16,500 shall be \$250.
- The fee to inspect electrical work having a complete value more than \$16,500 but less than \$25,000 shall be \$500.
- The fee to inspect electrical work having a complete value of \$25,000 or more shall be calculated as a percentage of the complete value in accordance with the schedule below:

\$25,000 to \$199,999	2.0%
\$200,000 to \$299,999	1.9%
\$300,000 to \$499,999	1.5%
\$500,000 to \$699,999	1.3%
\$700,000 to \$999,999	1.1%
\$1,000,000 & Higher	1.0%

SECTION THREE - REPEAL AND REPLACEMENT
Upon the effective date of this Ordinance, Lyon County, Kentucky Ordinance 15-6 shall be and is hereby repealed and replaced with the provisions of this Ordinance.
