ORDINANCE # 2025-07-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BENHAM KENTUCKY, ADDRESSING VACANT, ABANDONED, BLIGHTED AND DETERIORATED PROPERTIES AND ESTABLISHING AN ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION

SECTION ONE

The City of Benham finds that vacant, abandoned, blighted, and deteriorated properties exist within the City of Benham and threaten the public health, safety, morals and welfare of city residents; the city of Benham intends to utilize the authority granted in KRS 92.305, 99.700 to 99.30, and 132.012 to address such properties. The City of Benham finds the most effective method of enforcing ordinances that address vacant, abandoned, blighted, and deteriorated properties in the city is through a vacant property review commission pursuant to KRS 99.710. The Benham Council grants the Code Enforcement Board the authority to enforce this ordinance.

SECTION TWO

Provides that, if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phase of this ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such infirmities shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.

SECTION THREE

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR
