2025 PROPOSED TAX RATE

PUBLIC HEARING

The Wolfe County Fiscal Court will hold a public hearing on September 09, 2025 at 1:00 p.m. at the Wolfe County Courthouse for the purpose of obtaining citizens comments from the public regarding the proposed tax rate.

The tax rate levied last year was 7.8 cents per \$100 and produced revenues in the amount of \$195,629. This year's compensating rate is 7.4 cents per \$100 and will produce revenues in the amount of \$200,837. The Wolfe County Fiscal Court proposes a tax rate of 7.8 cents per \$100 which will produce a total of \$211,693 in revenues.

Revenue expected from New Property is \$10,856; revenue expected from Personal Property is \$67,463; revenue expected from Motor Vehicle is \$49,275; and revenue expected from Watercraft is \$687.

Revenue received in excess of last year's revenue will be used for Courthouse maintenance and repairs.

The Kentucky General Assembly requires that the Wolfe County Fiscal Court publish this notice with the above information contained herein.

PUBLIC HEARING

The Wolfe County Conservation District will hold a public hearing on Monday Sept 8, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. at the Farm Bureau Meeting Room for the purpose of obtaining citizens comments from the public regarding the proposed tax rate .

The tax rate levied last year was 4.6 cents per \$100 and produced revenues in the amount of \$112,928. This year's compensating rate is 4.2 cents per \$100 and will produce revenues in the amount of \$113,988. The Soil Conservation District proposes a tax rate of 4.6 cents per \$100 which will produce a total of \$124,845 in revenues.

Revenue expected from New Property is \$10,857; revenue expected from Personal Property is \$0.00; revenue expected from Motor Vehicle is \$0.00; and revenue expected from Watercraft is \$0.00.

Revenue received in excess of last year's revenue will be used for office equipment and property improvements and equipment maintenance.

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-0812

AN ORDINANCE OF THE WOLFE FISCAL COURT RELATING TO

STREET-LEGAL SPECIAL PURPOSE VEHICLES

WHEREAS, 2025 Ky. Acts ch. 89 (hereinafter "the Act") became law on March 26, 2025 and allows for the operation of street-legal special purpose vehicles on certain highways within the Commonwealth of Kentucky if allowed by ordinance of the local government within whose jurisdictional boundaries the highway is located; and

WHEREAS, the Act becomes effective on Friday, June 27, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Wolfe Fiscal Court has determined that it is appropriate to allow the operation of street-legal special purpose vehicles on specified highways within the jurisdictional boundaries of \_ Wolfe County in accordance with the Act and this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the fiscal court of county of Wolfe, Commonwealth of Kentucky:

SECTION 1.

Definitions

The definitions set forth in Section 1(1) of the 2025 Ky. Acts ch. 89 (hereinafter "the Act"), and as may be amended in the future by the Kentucky General Assembly, are adopted and incorporated by reference as if set forth fully herein.

SECTION 2.

Designated Highways

Option 1. Street-legal special purpose vehicles shall be allowed to the extent permitted by the Act on all highways that are located within the jurisdictional limits of Wolfe County.

SECTION 3.

Exceptions

Street-legal special purpose vehicles shall not be allowed to operate:

(a) On any highway, or portion thereof, located within the jurisdictional limits of Wolfe County unless allowed by this ordinance.

(b) On any highway, or portion thereof, that is a controlled access system, including but not limited to an interstate or parkway; or

(c) On any highway, or portion thereof, where the United States Department of Agriculture prohibits special purpose vehicles.

SECTION 4.

Prohibitions

(a) Street-legal special purpose vehicles are prohibited from traveling a distance greater than twenty (20) miles on a highway displaying centerline pavement markings.


(b) Minitrucks shall not be operated as street-legal special purpose vehicles on a highway that has been constructed pursuant to a federal highway program.

SECTION 5.

Effective Date


