of spring arrive in the mountains of North Carolina where I live, I want to immediately plant flowers on my deck and in my yard. But I've learned that I must wait until after Mother's Day to avoid the risk of late-spring frosts. It kills me when I see all the colorful blooms at our local hardware stores and nurseries, and I have to be patient.

But now it's almost time to plant. Those vivid bursts of color will bring me joy all summer, especially when hummingbirds and butterflies zoom in for a taste of nectar.

Color

Flowers range from vivid reds to soft whites and everything in-between.
