BUDGET SUMMARY

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Annual Budget and Appropriations.  
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF HICKMAN COUNTY, KENTUCKY:

WHEREAS, the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2025-26 was tentatively approved by the fiscal court on Monday, April 28th, 2025, and approved as to form and classification by the State Local Finance Office on May 5, 2025.  
The adoption and second reading are scheduled to be held on Thursday, May 22, 2025, at 8:00 a.m. in the office of the Hickman County Judge Executive.  
SECTION ONE: The following budget is adopted for the Fiscal Year 2025-26 and the amounts stated are appropriated for the purposes indicated.
