
The property will be sold under the following terms and conditions:

1. At the time of sale the successful bidder shall either pay full cash or make a deposit of fifteen
(15%) per cent of the purchase price with the balance on credit for 30 days, except that said
deposit shall be waived if the Plaintiff is the successful bidder at the sale. The bond shall bear
interest at the rate the judgment bears per annum from the date of sale until paid and shall have
the same force and effect as a judgment and shall remain and be a lien on the property until
paid. The purchaser(s) shall have the privilege of paying all of the balance of the purchase price
prior to the expiration of the time period listed above. The purchaser and the bond surety must
execute the Sale Bond and the Affidavit of Surety as required by Private Auctioneer's Contract.
2. The prospective purchaser shall also be aware that the Hickman Circuit Court entered an
