FEATURED PROGRAMS:

KIDS DIG-IN: HANDS-ON BIRDS & DINOSAURS EXPLORATION

The Kids Dig-In series is our interpretation of our Summer Reading prompt of “Unearth A Story.” We allow kids to dig into something new, something different, and something fun! The focus of the “digging” changes each session. This session, let’s dig into some bird and dinosaur facts. Led by

Tiffany Laracuenta, our explorers will learn all about birds and their crazy-cool connection to dinosaurs. They’ll learn bird facts and have some hands-on exploring. There will also be activities after the presentation. All abilities are welcome. (Ages 6-10)
