Our Friends at the Olympia Springs FD is bringing a Fire Truck for the kids to check out.

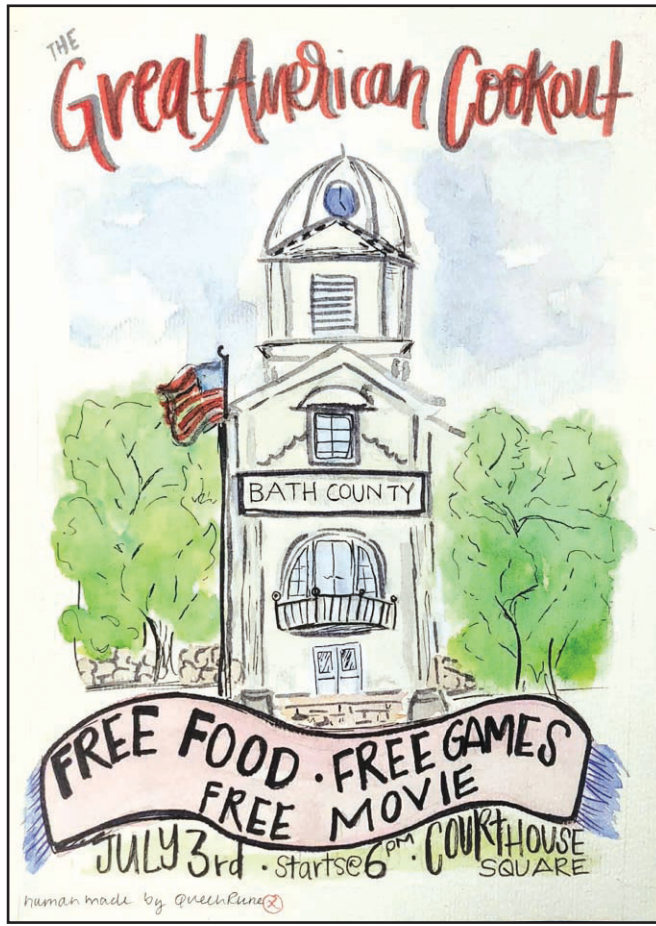
McCarty Inflatables will have us a Bounce House for the kids as well.

Let's get ready to "Show Hosses" for the 82nd Annual Owingsville Lions Club Horse Show.

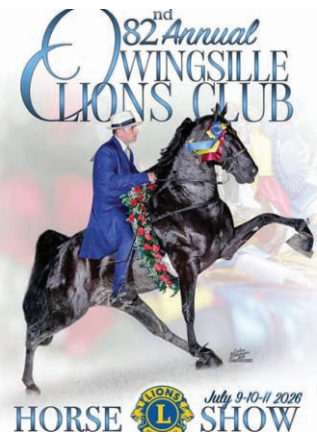
This year's show is scheduled for July 9 - 11 at the Owingsville Lions Club Park. There will be 69 show classes, and the show starts 6 p.m. nightly.
