ORDINANCE NO. 08122026-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BOONEVILLE, KENTUCKY BY WHICH THE CITY ANNEXES INTO THE CITY CORPORATE LIMITS CERTAIN REAL PROPERTIES

The City Commission of the City of Booneville, Kentucky has adopted Ordinance No. 08122026-1 annexing by consent certain real property into the corporate limits of the City of Booneville pursuant to KRS 81A.412. The properties annexed by consent of the current owners include the following:

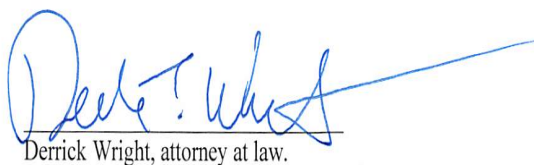
