

Bracken County Trap Team Earns Third at Kentucky State Shoot

On Saturday, June 6, the Bracken County High School Trap Team put Bracken County on the map at the USA Clay Target League Kentucky State Shoot. Competing with a record-breaking 14 athletes, the team battled extreme heat and tough competition to bring home an impressive third-place finish out of more than 20 teams - missing first place by just eight targets.

Leading the way was Alayna Caudill, who shot a perfect 100 straight, earning first place in the Varsity Female division and tying for first overall. In the championship shootoff, Caudill dropped her first target of the day but represented Bracken County with pride and determination.

Gavin Gallagher had an outstanding performance, shooting his first-ever 75 straight targets and finishing with a score of 97 out of 100. Close behind him was Dameon Streine with a 96, including a 25-straight round. Noah Tucker and Jacob Colemire each posted scores of 94 out of 100,

while Brycen Florer finished with a strong 91.

Every athlete contributed to the team's success, and several earned notable state placements:

- Rae Turner - 14th Place, Novice Female Division

- Eleanor Elam - 10th Place, JV Female Division

- Alayna Caudill - 1st Place, Varsity Female Division and 2nd Overall

- Ellie Gallagher - 13th Place, Varsity Female Division

- Gavin Gallagher - 20th Place, Varsity Male

Division and 21st Overall

- Dameon Streine - 29th Place, Varsity Male Division and 31st Overall

- Jacob Colemire - 44th Place, Varsity Male Division and Tied for 47th Overall

- Noah Tucker - Tied for 46th Place, Varsity Male Division and 49th Overall

The coaches are extremely proud of the team's accomplishments and are excited to see continued growth and improvement as they prepare for the National Championship in Michigan next month. With

strong performances throughout the season and a record number of athletes competing, the future looks bright for Bracken County Trap Shooting.
