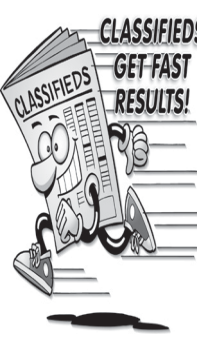

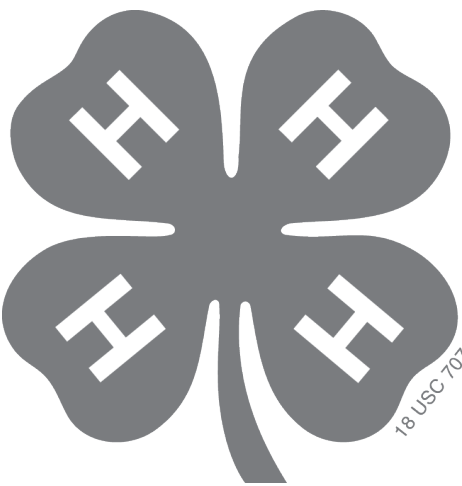

The Kentucky 4-H Culinary Challenge Jr. Contest tasks its members, ages 9-13, to use their food preparation skills, knowledge of nutrition and food safety, and leadership skills to prepare a serving or plate of food from recipes provided the day of event under judge observations. After preparing the recipe, teams make a presentation of their creation to judges, which are also required to demonstrate knowledge of: Nutritional value, serving size and preparation skills. Preparing for this contest has helped these three individuals hone their love for cooking and leadership.

According to Culinary Challenge Jr. Champion, Karena Gschwend, "through the Culinary Challenge, I have gained so many experiences from learning how to increase my culinary skills, being in front of a crowd, and interacting with adults. Culinary skills are important as I

grow older and one day live on my own. Whether it is for cooking for my own home, a potluck or bake sale, these skills will continue to be part of me as I grow older. Through Culinary Challenge, I continue to strengthen my ability in this area."

Jr. Culinary Challenge Team member, Emma Brown, shared that the Culinary Challenge Team is her favorite 4-H activity, "because I got to cook with my best friends." Emma also shared that learning how to cook and public speaking were some of the most important skills she learned in 2025.

Culinary Team Member, Zoey Bequeath, says that she uses the public speaking skills learned in 4-H and Culinary Challenge to also help her in her other 4-H activities include, "Communications contest, Poultry Showmanship, Recreation Club Leader Role, and when leading and helping during workshops." Zoey has also shared that, "Public Speaking also gives me confidence in school, when answering questions, and talking in class."
