Kentucky State Police Post 11 arrests substitute teacher for bringing a weapon to a McCreary County School

The Kentucky State Police (KSP) Post 11 London arrested a Whitley City man in reference to him bringing a knife onto school grounds.

On August 20, 2026, KSP Post 11 was contacted by the McCreary County School Board of Education regarding a complaint that a substitute teacher had brought a knife onto school property. Preliminary investigation determined that on August 13, 2026 Gilbert Irvin, 72, of Whitley City, Kentucky, brought a knife onto the school grounds. During that time, school staff did not believe that Irvin posed any threat to the students or staff at the school on the property, but his employment was terminated by the school board.

Due to bringing the weapon onto school grounds, a warrant was issued for Irvin.

Irvin has been arrested and charged with Possession of a Weapon on school property. This investigation remains ongoing by Trooper Craig Reed of KSP Post 11.

INSTALLATION/CONTRACT TIMELINE:

The contract shall be for a temporary gravel parking lot for Clinton County High School. The details the request should address are in the Request For Proposal solicitation that is available electronically upon request, or paper hard copy is available at the district central office at 1273 KY HWY 90 West, Suite 103, Albany, Kentucky 42602 through the close of business on September 3, 2026. Necessary documents, materials, and information appropriate to the solicited requirements should be delivered by September 8, 2026. Any adjustment to the length of contract, working days, and/or times must be approved by the District in writing before modifications to the timeline can occur.

TIME OF OPENING:

Proposals will be opened at 10:00 a.m. CDT/11:00 a.m. EDT, on Tuesday, September 8, 2026 or as soon thereafter as business circumstances of the board of education and superintendent permit. All proposals must be received by 9:30 a.m. CDT/10:30 a.m. EDT on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, and none will be considered thereafter. Failure to have proposal submitted prior to proposal opening will automatically prevent the reading of your proposal. We do not accept FAX proposals.
