ORDINANCE NUMBER 12-15-2025 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF APPOINTED CITY OFFICERS AND THE PERSONNEL PAY PLAN

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Fredonia, Kentucky, as follows:

Section 1. This ordinance shall replace Ordinance 12-17-2024. Effective for the first pay period of February 2026, the annual salary for the positions set forth below shall be as follows:

SALARIED	
(not including incentive pay)	Annual Salary

Section 2. Effective for the first pay period of February 2026, the Personnel Pay Plan of the City of Fredonia, Kentucky, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 3. In addition to the compensation set forth above in Section 2, each current employee of the City of Fredonia, Kentucky, hired on or before December 31, 2022, shall receive compensation in the sum of \$742.00 to be paid to the qualifying employee for the third pay period of December 2025, if still continuously employed by the City at that time. This is for general and consistent services rendered to the City of Fredonia for an employment period of no less than 365 days. Neither the Mayor nor the members of the City Council shall be eligible for any compensation contemplated within this section.



Section 4. In addition to the compensation set forth above in Sections 2 and 3, each current employee of the City of Fredonia, Kentucky, hired on or before December 31, 2022, shall receive compensation in the sum of \$1,000.00 to be paid to the qualifying employee for the third pay period of December 2025, pending an unmodified/unqualified result of the City Audit. This is for honorable and detailed services rendered to the City of Fredonia which has been shown with a successful unmodified/unqualified City Audit rating. Neither the Mayor nor the members of the City Council shall be eligible for any compensation contemplated within this section.

Section 5. This ordinance has been written in accordance with KRS 83A.070.

Whereas, certain changes and modification of said Ordinance have become necessary due to a major rate increase from the city's water supplier.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Fredonia, Kentucky as follows:
