"The Eddyville Riverport and Industrial Development Authority (hereinafter "ERIDA") is seeking bids for a riverport infrastructure project. The proposed project will consist of the installation of four (4) mooring dolphins within the natural bay of the

Eddyville Riverport, located along river mile 43 on the Cumberland River/Barkley Lake. Each dolphin will consist of a 30" diameter plumb pile with horizontal bracing and 30" diameter battered piles. The steel piles are anticipated to be driven no less than 70' in depth. The project scope will encompass furnishing material, fabrication, and installation of the four (4) mooring dolphins, and furnish & installation of the marker lights. All materials, fabrication and installation shall be in accordance with the design details and specifications at the locations identified within the drawings.
