General Duties and Responsibilities: Assists in the daily operation and maintenance of the water plant involving collection and distribution of water in compliance with established procedures, standards, laws, and ordinances. Inspects and monitors pumps, charts, gauges, wells, tanks, and meters daily. Adds and adjusts chemicals in accordance with prescribed standards. Assists lab personnel in collection of water samples. Prepares and maintains accurate reports and records. Forwards water samples, reports, and other documentation as required. Performs servicing requirements on plant and equipment including preventative maintenance and forwards requests for larger projects to supervisor. Monitors and maintain adequate inventory of spare parts, chemicals, equipment, and tools. Assists in maintaining clean and neat plants and grounds. Performs other related duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Training and Experience: Graduation from high school or equivalent supplemented by work experience acceptable by the Kentucky Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Cabinet to have received a Class I (immediately upon completion of one year employment), II, or III Water Plant Operators License.

Certification/Licensing Requirements: Must be able to obtain a Class I Water Plant Operator License issued by the Commonwealth of Kentucky immediately upon completion of one year of employment in the position; or possess a Class II, or III Water Plant Operator License issued by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Cabinet.
