

Grand Jury hands down 18 indictments

The Harrison County Grand Jury handed down the following 18 indictments on Tuesday, Feb. 3:

- Charolette Chambers, aka Charlotte Chambers, 61, was indicted for possession of a handgun by a convicted felon and persistend felony offender (second degree). The alleged offenses took place Jan. 10.

- Charolette Chambers, aka Charlotte Chambers, 61, was indicted for trafficking in a controlled substance (first degree, first offense, methamphetamin, two or more grams), trafficking in a controlled substance (first degree, first offense, fentanyl/heroin), trafficking in a controlled substance (first degree, first offense, Oxycodone, 10 or more dosage units), trafficking in a controlled substance (third degree, first offense, Gabapentin, more than 120 dosage units), trafficking in a controlled substance (third degree, first offense, Alprazolam, less than 20 dosage units), trafficking in marijuana (first offense, less than eight ounces), possession of drug paraphernalia and persistent felony offender (second degree) Possession of firearm at time of offense applied to all counts. The alleged offenses occurred Jan. 10.

- Samantha Jo Colvin, aka Samantha Jo Reames, aka Samantha Jo Ohara, 38, was indicted for fraudulent possession of a food stamp identification card. The alleged incident occurred between Aug. 16, 2025, and Sept. 14, 2025.

- Brandon Andreas Creager, 32, was indicted for eight counts of burglary (third degree), eight counts complicity to burglary (third

degree), possession of burglary tools, theft of services, possession of marijuana, possession of drug paraphernalia and persistent felony offender (second degree). The alleged offenses occurred between Jan. 6 and Jan. 14.

- Samantha Leigh Davis, 32, was indicted for trafficking in a controlled substance (first degree, first offense, methamphetamine, less than two grams), possession of drug paraphernalia, license to be in possession, no registration receipt, no/expired registration plates, failure to produce insurance card, failure of owner to maintain required insurance (first offense) and persistent felony offender (second degree). The alleged incidents took place Jan. 3.

- Kendra Darlene Earlywine, aka Kendra Darlene Lappin, Kendra Earlywine-Lappin, Kendra Earlywine Lappin and Kendra Darlene McElfresh, 38, was indicted for eight counts of burglary (third degree), eight counts complicity to burglary (third degree), possession of burglary tools, theft of services and persistent felony offender (first degree). The alleged offenses occurred between Jan. 6 and Jan. 14.

- Amanda Lynn Fannin, aka

Amanda Lynn Williams, 45, was indicted for bail jumping (first degree). The alleged incident took place Jan. 20.

- Elijah Jibril Hamler, aka Elijah Stell, 33, was indicted for aggravated trafficking in a controlled substance (first degree, fentanyl), aggravated trafficking in a controlled substance (first degree, carfentanil/fentanyl derivatives) and trafficking in a controlled (first degree, second or subsequent offense, trafficking in a controlled substance (third degree, second or subsequent offense, Tramadol, less than 20 dosage units), importing carfentanil, fentanyl or fentanyl derivatives, importing heroin and persistent felony offender (first degree). The alleged offenses occurred June 17, 2025.

- Blake Curtiss Hobbs, 34, was indicted for trafficking in a controlled substance (first degree, second or subsequent offense, methamphetamine, less than two grams), possession of drug paraphernalia, theft of identity, carrying a concealed deadly weapon and persistent felony offender (second degree). The alleged incidents took place Jan. 3.

- Charles Travis Martin, 47,

was indicted for strangulation (first degree, domestic violence related), wanton endangerment (first degree), assault (fourth degree, domestic violence-minor injury), alcohol intoxication in a public place (first or second offense), resisting arrest, criminal mischief (second degree) and persistent felony offender (second degree). The alleged offenses took place Jan. 15.

- Charles Travis Martin, 47, was indicted for assault (second degree, domestic violence), wanton endangerment (first degree) and persistent felony offender (second degree). The alleged incidents occurred Jan. 31.

- Charles Travis Martin, 47, was indicted for assault (second degree, domestic violence), terrorististic threatening (third degree) and persistent felony offender (second degree). The alleged incidents occurred July 12, 2025.

- Kyle Nicholas McBride, 23, was indicted for two counts of rape (third degree) and

sodomy. The alleged offenses occurred Dec. 2, 2025.

- David Lee Ohara, aka David Lee O'Hara, 55, was indicted for complicity to fraudulent possession of a food stamp identification card and persistent felony offender (second degree). The alleged offenses took place between Aug. 16, 2025 and Sept. 14, 2025.

- Bradley Aaron Rice, 37, was indicted for bail jumping (first degree) and persistent felony offender (first degree). The alleged offenses took place Jan. 20.

- Candace Lace Slade, 40, was indicted for falsely reporting an incident which generates an emergency response and criminal mischief (second degree). The alleged incidents occurred Dec. 10, 2025.

- Gary Dean Smith, 39, was indicted for wanton endangerment (first degree), stalking (first degree), assault (fourth degree, domestic violence, minor injury), five counts of terrorististic threatening (third

degree), resisting arrest, three counts menacing and disorderly conduct (second degree). The alleged incidents occurred Jan. 13.
