Sophomore Russ Persinger followed with a ground out to second that brought Green home with the first run of the game.

Harrison Co. exploded for nine runs in the second frame. 14 batters came to the plate in an inning in which eight straight batters for the Breds reached base at one point. Freshman Ian Hopkins, Green, junior Jordan Persinger, senior Cooper Slade, sophomore Brack Coy and freshman Easton Martin all drove in at least one run in the decisive frame that plated nine runs and put the Breds in the driver's seat with a 10-

0 lead. Green accounted for Harrison Co.'s lone run in the top of the third. After walking to begin the inning, Green advanced to second on an errant pickoff throw by the pitcher. Two batters later, Green scored on an error by the shortstop, increasing the advantage for the Breds to 11-0.


Much like Harrison Co. did in the second frame, the Breds sent 12 batters to the dish in the fourth inning, highlighted by Walker's shot over the right field fence. Altogether, six Thorobreds crossed the plate in the frame, setting the final score at 17-0.

Harrison Co. remained unbeaten with a record of 9-0 while the Eagles dropped to 1-21.
