coach Destiny Mullins said getting the run in the frame was big, but ending the inning, in that way, took the wind out of their sails.

"I think tying it up in the first was a big moment," Mullins said. "I wish that the momentum from that moment would have carried us a little bit more."

Raceland seized the momentum into the third as Gauze led off the inning with a single up the middle in an inning that would see 11 Rams' hitters come to the plate. Raceland racked up six of its 13 hits in the frame while tacking on seven runs for an 8-1 lead after three. Adkins credited his team with making key in-game adjustments to

get the bats going in the rout.

"There's a lot of maturity with this team as young as they are," Adkins said. "They've moved around in positions, and they are still learning positions. But as we move forward, they are going to have to grow up fast because we are coming down the stretch and our schedule doesn't get any easier."

Poplin started the fourth with a single, and the Rams followed with singles from Nim Maynard and Fannin's third hit of the night. Bryleigh Kennard and Jill Riffe

brought home runs with a pair of sacrifices as the Rams plated four more runs to put the run rule in effect, heading into the fifth. Poplin, Maynard and Ally McMackin turned in two hits each.

With the win, Raceland moves to 2-2 in district play with a trip to Vanceburg Thursday in another crucial contest with Lewis County as the hope of staying away from the four seed looms in the balance.

"It's big and even Thursday's game is big," Adkins said of the win. "You want to be in the

two spot, and you want to be the home team."

Mullins said the loss puts her team behind the eight ball with only one more game to play in district when they head to Lewis County on May 5.

"It's definitely a tough situation," Mullins said. "We would like to avoid it as much as possible, as would anyone. We just have to do our best to try to get a second district win against Lewis when that time comes."
