

NOTICE OF ADOPTION AND SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 26-05WC

The Fiscal Court of the County of Warren, Kentucky gave second reading to and adopted Ordinance No. 26-05WC summarized below at a Meeting of the Fiscal Court on March 12, 2026.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE FISCAL COURT OF WARREN COUNTY, KENTUCKY ("COUNTY"), AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF WARREN COUNTY, KENTUCKY GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS, IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000,000, (THE "BONDS"); AUTHORIZING THE LEVY OF A DIRECT ANNUAL TAX ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE COUNTY, IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER TAXES, IN AN AMOUNT SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON THE BONDS, TO THE EXTENT THAT REVENUES ARE NOT SUFFICIENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE TAKING OF ALL OTHER ACTIONS, INCLUDING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OR A DISCLOSURE DISSEMINATION AGENT AGREEMENT, FEDERAL TAX CERTIFICATE, IRS FORM 8038G, AND/OR SUCH OTHER DOCUMENTS, AGREEMENTS AND CERTIFICATES, NECESSARY OR REQUIRED FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THE BONDS.

This Ordinance authorizes the issuance of Warren County, Kentucky General Obligation Bonds, at such times, in one or more series, denominations, other identifying name, and with each series to be dated as determined by the County Judge/Executive, with the advice from the Financial Advisor, without further action of the Fiscal Court, in an aggregate principal amount of all Bonds issued pursuant to the Ordinance not to exceed \$20,000,000 ("Bonds"); the levy of a direct annual tax on all taxable property within the County, in addition to all other taxes, in an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the Bonds, if revenues are not sufficient to pay debt service; authorizing the establishment of certain funds to provide for the collection of revenues from the facility and to the extent required proceeds of the tax, if any; and authorizing certain other actions with regard to the issuance of the Bonds. The Bonds shall be full general obligations of the County and, for the payment of said Bonds and interest thereon, the full faith, credit and revenue of the County of Warren, Kentucky is pledged for the prompt payment thereof.

Proceeds from the sale of the Bonds will be used by Warren County, Kentucky, for the purpose financing of: (i) the acquisition of equipment for the County fire department including, but not being limited to, tankers, pumps, and other related equipment, including the reimbursement of any expenditures relating thereto pursuant to Reimbursement Resolution No. 25-03; (ii) the acquisition, development, construction, and operation of facilities or buildings for the County Sheriff's Department, including the reimbursement of any expenditures relating thereto pursuant to Reimbursement Resolution No. 25-03; (iii) acquisition, development, construction, and operation, of other County land, facilities, or buildings, as approved by the County Fiscal Court, located within the boundaries of the County, to be owned and operated by the County and which have a useful or economic life greater than one (1) year, including the reimbursement of any expenditures relating thereto pursuant to Reimbursement Resolution No 25-03, including any development or pre-construction expenditures; (iv) the renovation and improvement to the County's parks and recreation facilities and land; (v) the payment of capitalized and/or accrued interest, if any; and (vi) the payment of the Cost of Issuance.

The Bonds are being issued pursuant to KRS §66.011 through §66.220 and KRS §67.083. In compliance with §159 of the Constitution of Kentucky and Kentucky Revised Statutes and for the purpose of providing funds required to pay the principal and interest on the Bonds when due. The Ordinance authorizes the levy upon all the taxable property in Warren County, Kentucky each year as long as any of the Bonds are outstanding, a direct annual tax sufficient, to the extent other lawful available monies of Warren County are not provided for that purpose. The County has covenant to levy and collect each year, that the Bonds remain outstanding, a tax in an amount sufficient to provide for the full payment of the principal of and interest thereon provided, however, that said tax will be levy only to the extent that the project revenues, or other revenues received from taxes or other sources, are not sufficient to provide for the full payment of the accruing interest and maturing principal on the Bonds each year.

NOTICE OF HEARING Warren County, Kentucky General Obligation Bonds Series 2026

(Fire Department and Sheriffs Office)

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to a petition from the Warren County Fiscal Court requesting the State Local Debt Officer to approve the financial plan whereby the County proposes to issue its General Obligation Bonds, Series 2026 in an approximate principal amount not to exceed \$20,000,000. The proceeds will be used to complete the Finance (i) the acquisition of equipment for the County fire department, including the reimbursement of any expenditures relating thereto; (ii) the acquisition, development, construction, and operation of facilities for the County Sheriffs Department, including the reimbursement of any expenditures relating thereto (iii) acquisition, development, construction, and operation, of other County land, facilities, or buildings, as approved by the County Fiscal Court to be owned and operated by the County with a useful or economic life greater than one(1) year, including the reimbursement of any expenditures relating thereto; (iv) renovation and improvement to the County's parks and recreation facilities and land; (v) the payment of capitalized and/or accrued interest, if any; and (vi) the payment of the Cost of Issuance.. A hearing will be held in the Conference Room, Department for Local Government, 100 Airport Road, Frankfort, Kentucky, on Tuesday, March 31, 2026 at 2:00 PM, (Prevailing Eastern Time) to consider whether or not the financial plan for the issuance of the 2026 Bonds should be approved.

Petitioner, Warren County Fiscal Court is responsible for the publication of this notice and for the information contained herein. Specific questions about the type of project should be directed to the petitioners. The purpose of this notice is to comply with KRS 66.310 by notifying the public that the petitioner intends to issue bonds or other indebtedness in the total amount and at the terms set out herein.

At this hearing, any taxpayer may appear and will be given an opportunity to be heard.

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




King Classic Sudoku
