Austin Peay beats Lady Tops

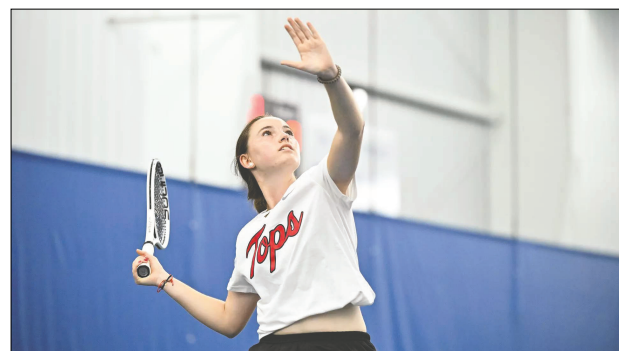

Western Kentucky's women's tennis team lost to Austin Peay 4-1 on Saturday at the Warren County Tennis Facility at Michael O. Buchanon Park.

The Lady Toppers (10-13) earned a singles win against Austin Peay (11-4) at the No. 3 position from Virginia Madueño, as well as a doubles win at the No. 1 position from Madueño and Emily Schut.

"I think this is one of our first matches since we are playing together since our teammate got injured and I think it's gone really well, especially for one of the first times playing together. I think we have a great energy, which really makes a difference," Schut said in a news release. "I think we fought really hard today in doubles."

Western Kentucky freshman Virginia Madueño claimed a singles win in the Lady Toppers' 4-1 loss Saturday to Austin Peay at the Warren County Tennis Facility at Michael O. Buchanon Park.

Peay is now 29-16, with WKU leading.

The doubles team of Schut and Madueño is now 2-2 together this season, with all four of those matches at the No. 1 doubles position. Madueño and Schut each have nine doubles wins this season.

Schut's doubles win was the 23rd of her WKU career, which ranks 13th in program history.

Madueño improved to 15-4 in singles matches this season with her win

over Austin Peay. She is now 5-1 from the No. 3 position. The 15 singles wins are tied for sixth-most in a single season in program history. Only Rachel Hermanova has more singles wins in a season as a true freshman in program history. Hermanova had 19 singles wins during the 2022 season.

"I think the key was just staying confident during the entire match, keeping my energy level up and then staying aggressive

and playing inside the baseline, hitting big serves and hitting with my forehand," Madueño said. "I think I did a great job at that."

The Lady Toppers will wrap up the regular season on Thursday with a 1 p.m. CT Senior Day match against Middle Tennessee at the Warren County Tennis Facility at Michael O. Buchanon Park.

"We played some really good singles today at points," WKU coach Greg Davis said. "The big thing was just not being able to push through and get that doubles point. I think it would have changed the match completely. We had some really good performances today. One doubles played extremely well - Emily and Virginia. Then I thought we had some good singles performances today out of Emily, Virginia and Ari. They definitely picked it up today."

WKU names Lane as director of scouting

Western Kentucky's football program announced the hiring of Chase Lane as the program's director of scouting on Friday.

Lane joins the Hilltoppers after serving as the director of recruiting for Georgia Tech's football NIL collective. In that role, he planned visits and hosted prospective student-athletes, while also assisting in transfer portal strategy.

Lane played football at Texas A&M from 2019-22 and graduated with an undergraduate degree in communications. In 25 games over his final three seasons with the Aggies, he caught 48 passes for 617 yards and two touchdowns, and helped his team win the Orange

Bowl during the 2020 season. He also played at Georgia Tech from 2023-24.
