PUBLIC NOTICE REGISTERED PERMIT-BY-RULE

Daniels Sharpsmart, Inc. proposes to submit an application for a registered permit-by-rule Medical Waste Transfer Station facility to the Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management, pursuant to 401 KAR 47:110. The registration shall become effective five (5) business days after the cabinet receives it, with the exception of medical waste transfer stations which become effective thirty (30) days after the cabinet receives it, unless the cabinet denies the registration within that time. The proposed facility will:

Transfer medical waste from hospitals, outpatient facilities, and other medical waste generators and temporarily store the waste prior to further processing at a permitted medical waste treatment facility.

NOTICE OF ADOPTION

The Fiscal Court of the County of Warren, Kentucky gave reading to and adopted the Resolution below at a Regular Meeting of the Fiscal Court held on April 30, 2026, at the Warren County Courthouse, 429 East 10 th Street, Bowling Green, Kentucky:

A RESOLUTION OF THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF WARREN, KENTUCKY ("COUNTY"), AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF WARREN COUNTY, KENTUCKY REVENUE BONDS, IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,750,000 (THE "BOND"), FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE EXPANSION AND CONSTRUCTION OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SKYPAC FACILITIES OWNED BY THE COUNTY AND OPERATED AS A FINE ARTS CENTER; AUTHORIZING THE PLEDGE OF THE TRANSIENT ROOM TAX, AND THE REVENUES THEREFROM, TO THE PAYMENT OF THE BOND; AUTHORIZING SKYPAC TO PROCEED WITH REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR THE PROJECT; AND AUTHORIZING SUCH OTHER ACTIONS, DOCUMENTS, AGREEMENTS, AND CERTIFICATES, NECESSARY OR REQUIRED, FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THE BOND AND THE FINANCING OF THE PROJECT.

This Resolution authorizes the County to issue its revenue bonds, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$2,750,000 (the "Bonds"), for the purpose of financing (i) the cost of the structural improvements and expansion to the Southern Kentucky Performing Arts Center; (ii) the payment of capitalized and/or accrued interest, if any; and, (iii) the payment of the Cost of Issuance. The Bonds are authorized pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 58, KRS §91A.390(8) and KRS §91A.392.

The Resolution provides that the Bonds shall not constitute an indebtedness of the County and will be paid out of revenues pledged for the payment of the Bonds.
