ORDINANCE NO. 2026-04

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE JOINT ZONING ORDINANCE OF WARREN COUNTY AS IT APPLIES TO THE CITY OF PLUM SPRINGS.

WHEREAS, after proper notice and pursuant to applicable state statutes, the Warren County Fiscal Court, Commonwealth of Kentucky modified the Joint Zoning Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the City of Plum Springs hereby adopts the following changes to said Joint Ordinance as they apply to the City of Plum Springs pursuant to KRS 100 and the police power of the City of Plum Springs, and

WHEREAS, after proper notice and pursuant to applicable state statutes, the City of Plum Springs held its regular meeting on June 11th, 2026, and the City duly considered input from the public, and reviewed the record from the Warren County Fiscal Court and,

WHEREAS, at its regular scheduled meeting, the Plum Springs City Commission made the following alterations, modifications and changes to the Warren County Joint Ordinance as it applies to the City of Plum Springs:

1. Article 4, section F is amended and the requirements for accessory buildings as defined in the Joint Ordinance found in Article 4 Paragraph F, Subsection 2 and 3 are eliminated to the extent that they apply to accessory buildings in the city of Plum Springs.

2. That the City of Plum Springs City Commission dissent from those provisions and do not agree to them.

3. That the proposed Joint Ordinance by the County of Warren is adopted in all other respects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Plum Springs, Kentucky as follows:

DULY ADOPTED pursuant to KRS 100 in that this Ordinance was introduced on the 11th day of June 2026, given final reading on 11th day of June, 2026, and said Ordinance shall be in full force upon signature, recordation and publication in summary pursuant to KRS 100.
