## Joines Releases Appalachian Tribute Single

Central City native Danny Joines is stepping into the spotlight after nearly two decades behind the scenes in the music industry.

A longtime tour manager, producer and multi-instrumentalist, Joines has released his new solo single, Lonesome Sound Of A Fiddle, featuring duet vocalist Sandy Shortridge. The song was co-written by Joines and Toni Krantz.

The single pays tribute to the high-lonesome sound of Appalachia, drawing inspiration from bluegrass pioneer Bill Monroe and the rich musical heritage of Kentucky.

Joines said the quiet of the 2020 lockdown gave him time to reconnect with his own music and storytelling after years spent supporting other artists on the road.

The song blends Joines' fiddle work and production experience with Shortridge's vocal harmonies, creating a sound rooted in Appalachian tradition.

Its accompanying music video was filmed at Jerusalem Ridge and the Bill Monroe Homeplace in Rosine, highlighting Ohio County's deep connection to bluegrass music.

Joines has worked alongside artists including John Schneider, Christian Davis and Masters Voice. With the release of Lonesome Sound Of A Fiddle, Joines is making the transition from behind-the-scenes production work to center stage as a recording artist.
