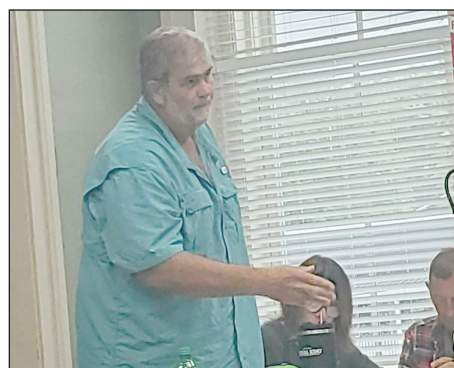
The Fiscal Court approved the following: County Attorney Bond renewal #212 22 44, May Cash transfers, Road Fund to borrow \$236,481 from the General Fund until Flex Funds are issued and the Flex funds will reimburse the General Fund once the flex money is received, and Ordinance # EC26-18 Data Center Moratorium, first reading was held.
