EDMONSON COUNTY 2026 ADOPTED TAX RATES

The Edmonson County Fiscal Court formally adopts the 2026 tax rates.

The current tax rates are in cents per \$100.00.

Real Property	12.2
Tangible Property	19.5
Motor Vehicle	17.1
Inventory	19.5
Watercraft	17.1
Aircraft	19.5
Bank Shares	20.0

The Edmonson County Fiscal Court held a public hearing on September 10th, 2026 at 4:00 p.m. at the Edmonson County Courthouse for the purpose of obtaining comments from the public regarding the proposed tax rate.

The tax rate levied last year was 12.2 and produced revenues in the amount of \$1,269,862.

This year's compensating rate is 11.9 and will produce revenues in the amount \$1,310,545. The Edmonson County Fiscal Court proposed a tax rate of 12.2 which will produce a total of \$1,343,584 in revenues.

Revenue expected from New Property is \$37,535; revenue expected from Personal Property is\$106,085; revenue expected from Motor Vehicle is \$230,780; and revenue expected from Watercraft is \$25,996.

Revenue received in excess of last year's revenue will be used for General Fund utilization for Edmonson County Fiscal Court expenses.

The Kentucky General Assembly requires that the Edmonson County Fiscal Court publish this notice with the above information contained herein.

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LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that Edmonson County Water District ("District") plans to file with the Public Service Commission on or before Sept 28, 2026, to adjust certain recurring charges. The proposed effective date is November 2, 2026. The proposed charges are as follows:

MISCELLANEOUS FEE

There shall be added to the customer's bill, listed as a separate line item, an amount equal to any fee, tax, assessment, etc., now or hereafter imposed by local legislative authorities on active customers of Edmonson County Water District whether by ordinance, franchise or other means. Such amount shall be added exclusively to bills of customers receiving service within the territorial limits of the authority imposing the fee.

Where more than one such fee is imposed, each of the charges applicable to each customer shall be added to the customer's bill and listed as separate line items.

Where the local legislative authority imposes a flat, fixed amount on active customers of Edmonson County Water District, the fee applied to the bills of customers receiving service within the territorial boundaries of the authority, shall be in the form of a flat dollar amount.

The amount of such fee added to the customer's bill shall be determined in accordance with the terms of the ordinance, franchise or other directive agreed to by Edmonson County Water District.

- Any person may examine this tariff filing at the PSC located at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky, Monday - Friday, 8:00 am - 4:30 pm or on the PSC website at <http://psc.ky.gov>; telephone (502) 564-3940.
- Any person may submit comments regarding this tariff filing by mail to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602; or through its website at <http://pscky.gov>.
- The recurring charge contained in this notice are the recurring charges passed by Fiscal Court Ordinance EC26-23 on 8-31 2026.
- Any person may submit a timely written request for intervention by mail to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602. The request for intervention must establish the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.
- If the PSC does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication or mailing of notice, the PSC may take final action on the tariff filing.

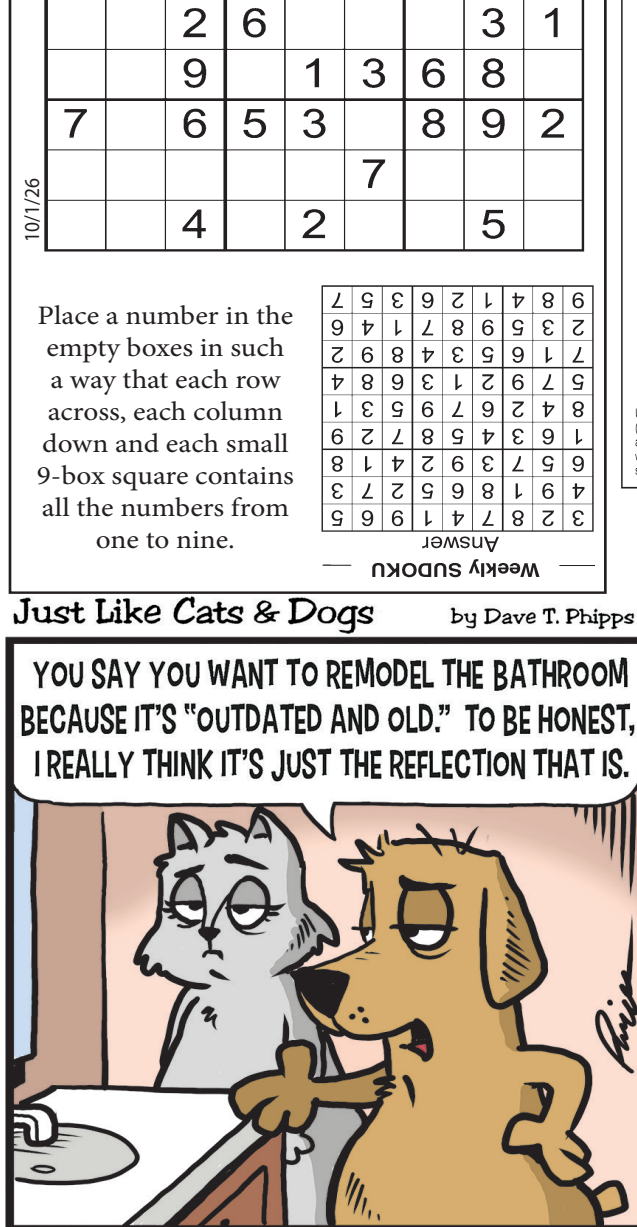

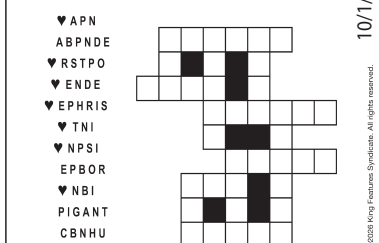
