HB 265 would create a process for solvent workers' compensation self-insurance pools to follow in order to dissolve. This option would only be available to solvent companies that are not the subject of delinquency proceedings. The measure also prevents authorization of new groups.

HB 280 would grant the Kentucky Board of Nursing the authority to investigate the licenses of nurses holding credentials from other states and ensure that any nurse practicing in Kentucky under an out-of-state license meets the same standards and requirements as Kentucky-licensed nurses. The bill also modernizes school health policies by updating rules related to prescribed rescue medications, including rescue inhalers, nebulizers, glu-

cagon, and epinephrine, helping ensure schools are better prepared to respond to student health emergencies.

HB 312 would allow Kentucky adults between the ages of 18 and 20 to obtain a provisional concealed carry license,

which has the same requirements as Kentucky's standard concealed carry license: a background check, training, and proficiency in handling and operating a firearm.
