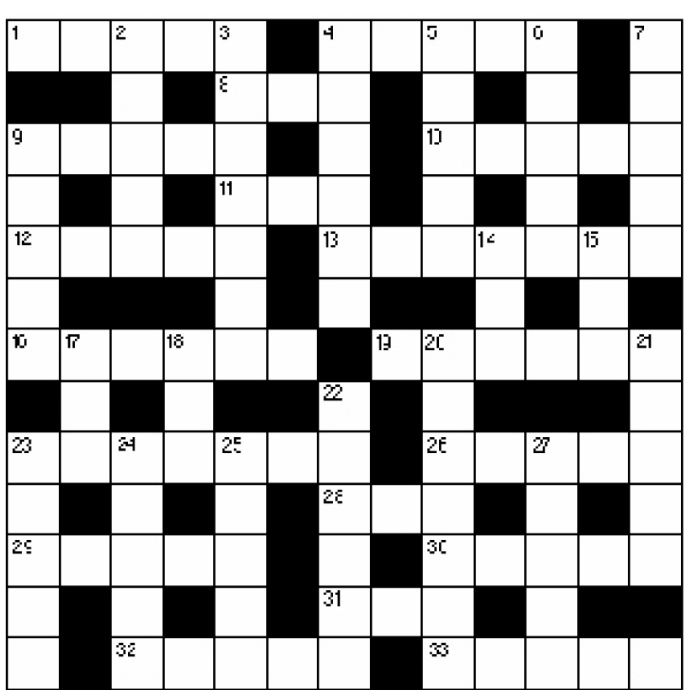

These plans come with unique benefits and restrictions. Finally, Medicare Part D is stand-alone prescription drug insurance.

Original Medicare, Parts A and B, covers a person on Medicare at 80%. The remaining 20% is called co-insurance or cost-sharing and is the responsibility of the person on Medicare to pay. However, for those on Original Medicare,
