LIHEAP summer cooling signups

Aug. 3-Sept. 11

Kentucky households can apply for LIHEAP Summer Subsidy from August 3 thru September 11 to help offset cooling costs with a one-time electric benefit. Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, or until funds are depleted.

Interested households in Elliott County should contact the Northeast Kentucky Commu-

nity Action Agency Office in Sandy Hook at 606-738-6577.

Households must meet eligibility requirements, including household income of up to and including 150 percent of the Federal Poverty Guidelines to qualify for assistance. Benefits are paid directly to the household's electric vendor.

No disconnect notice, past-due bill, or eviction notice is required to apply. Assistance received during previous LIHEAP components does not affect eligibility.

Household Hints

√Remove tarnish from silver or silverplated candleholders by submerging them in a container lined with tin foil, shiny side up, with a mix of 1 tablespoon of baking soda per cup of very hot water for 3-4 minutes; remove them and rinse in clear water; and, dry with a soft cloth.

√Before storing winter boots made of sheepskin (Uggs) clean by brushing with a soft bristle brush; use the brush to wash the boots with a mix of water and 1-2 teaspoons of mild detergent; rinse and air dry.

√For an aromatherapy smell in the house, add cinnamon, orange, or lemon peels to a container of 1 cup water and 1/2 cup white vinegar and boil the mixture on stove.

√Flush hard water deposits from a sink aerator with 1 cup of hot white vinegar.

√To prepare apples for

freezing, cut pieces in the shape they will be cooked; toss pieces in lemon juice and pat dry (to prevent apples from turning brown); place cut pieces on parchment lined sheet paper; flash freeze in freezer for 1-2 hours; and, transfer to freezer storage container and freezer.

2026 PROPOSED TAX RATE

PUBLIC HEARING

The Elliott County Ambulance Service will hold a public hearing on September 4, 2026, 5:00 p.m., at the Elliott County Ambulance Service for the purpose of obtaining comments from the public regarding the proposed tax rate.

The tax rate levied last year was 9.60 cents per \$100.00 and produced revenues in the amount of \$179,114. This year's compensating rate is 9.50 cents per \$100.00 and will produce revenues in the amount of \$182,735.00. The Elliott County Ambulance Service proposes a tax rate of 9.80 cents per \$100 which will produce a total of \$188,506.00 in revenues.

Revenue expected from New Property is \$1,981.69; revenue expected from Personal Property is \$31,312.27; revenue expected from Motor Vehicle is \$ 48,103.00; and revenue expected from Watercraft is \$ 1,600.00. Revenue received in excess of last year's revenue will be used for general fund operations.

The Kentucky General Assembly requires that the Elliott County Ambulance Service publish this notice with the above information contained herein.
