REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS PLANNING, APPLICATION AND PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION SERVICES

ESTILL COUNTY FISCAL COURT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

The Estill County Fiscal Court and Kentucky River Foothills Development Council are accepting proposals for professional services from certified CDBG Administrators for planning, application, management, technical assistance, and program implementation services for a joint Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) housing project. The scope of services is expected to be required from development through project closeout of the CDBG project.

Part One: Management and Administration

The level and scope of services to be provided under Part One will be determined by the County and KRFDC. A lump sum, fixed price fee will also be required for services subsequently included in an agreement under Part One. Examples of services which the consultant must be prepared and qualified to provide under Part One are as follows:

1. Assist the County and KRFDC in development, application, implementation, and overall administration for CDBG funding for the project.
2. Assist the County in meeting equal opportunity, citizen participation, and fair housing requirements for participation in the CDBG program and other funding sources, including preparation of Section 3 Plan.
3. Prepare an environmental assessment of the program, including consideration of historic preservation concerns and assist the County in meeting all environmental clearance procedures required by the State.
4. Assist the County in meeting financial, administration, and bookkeeping requirements of the program, including preparation of requests for payment.
5. Assist the County in meeting record keeping requirements of the program, including the establishment and maintenance of a filing system.
6. Assist the County and KRFDC in contract administration and monitoring requirements of the program, including enforcement of labor standards and conducting preconstruction conferences as required.
7. Prepare a final report as required by the State upon completion of the program.
8. Furnish the County and KRFDC with forms required for implementation of the project activities included in the application.
9. Furnish staff training to carry out project activities.
10. Prepare any report required by the state to complete the program.
11. Assist the County and KRFDC in administering housing rehabilitation, property acquisition, and relocation activities if required in program.

Part Two: Proposal

In order to be considered, proposals must be submitted by mail to Donnie Watson, Judge Executive of the **Estill County Fiscal Court, at 130 Main St. Room 101, Irvine, KY 40336** or by email to donniew@estillcounty.net at or before **10:00 am, Monday, March 30th, 2026**. The County reserves the right to reject any or all proposals. All paper copy proposals should be sealed and marked on the outside, "CDBG ADMINISTRATION PROPOSAL." Electronic submission should be in PDF format and clearly marked as "CDBG ADMINISTRATION PROPOSAL" in the email subject line.

Proposals will be evaluated and ranked on the basis of the following considerations:

Technical Approach/Understanding of CDBG Program	20
Work Management Plan	10
Experience of Proposed Personnel	20
Corporate Experience	20
Familiarity with Local Context	15
Cost	15

Proposals will be reviewed by a committee of County and KRFDC staff. No on-site interviews will be conducted.


