Public Notice Ordinance Number 26 – 1457
Fleming County Fiscal Court

The Fleming County Fiscal Court passed the second reading of AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ENERGY PROJECT ASSESSMENT DISTRICT (EPAD) PROGRAM PURSUANT TO KRS 65.205 TO 65.209 TO ADVANCE THE CONSERVATION AND EFFICIENT USE OF ENERGY AND WATER RESOURCES WITHIN FLEMING COUNTY, KENTUCKY BY ALLOWING FOR ENERGY PROJECTS TO BE FINANCED BY ASSESSMENTS IMPOSED UPON THE REAL PROPERTY BEING IMPROVED THROUGH THE ENERGY PROJECTS; PROVISION OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PROGRAM; THE STATEMENT OF THE INTENTION THAT ASSESSMENTS WILL BE UTILIZED TO SUPPORT PRIVATE SECTOR ENERGY PROJECTS; THE DESIGNATION OF THE EPAD AND ITS BOUNDARIES; THE PROVISION FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE EPAD PROGRAM; THE DETERMINATION OF THE PROCEDURE BY WHICH OWNERS OF REAL PROPERTY MAY PETITION THE COUNTY FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM; AND THE DESIGNATION OF [THE FLEMING COUNTY SHERIFF OR OTHER APPLICABLE COUNTY SHERIFF] AS THE COLLECTOR OF THE ASSESSMENT.
