**ORDINANCE NO. 2026-002**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GLENCOE, GALLATIN COUNTY, KENTUCKY, DESIGNATING AND ESTABLISHING CERTAIN STREETS AS PUBLIC STREETS FOR PURPOSES OF OWNERSHIP, CONTROL, AND MAINTENANCE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Glencoe (the "City") possesses the authority under Kentucky law to establish, accept, and maintain public streets within the City limits; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to formally recognize and designate certain streets as public streets for all municipal purposes, including ownership, control, and maintenance; and

**WHEREAS**, the designation of these streets as public streets is necessary to ensure proper maintenance, public access, and governmental responsibility; NOW, THEREFORE,

**SECTION 1. Designation of Public Streets.**

The following streets are hereby designated, declared, and established as public streets of the City of Glencoe, Kentucky, for all governmental purposes, including but not limited to ownership, regulation, repair, and maintenance:

- Collins Street
- East Howard Street
- Grace Street
- Green Street
- Hawthorne Street
- Noel Street
- Porter Street
- Sonny Rider Lane
- Stephenson Street
- Webster Street
- West Howard Street

**SECTION 2. Public Way Designation.**

Sunny Rider Lane is hereby established as a public way, owned and maintained by the City of Glencoe. The City shall assume full responsibility for upkeep, repair, and any improvements deemed necessary for the safety and benefit of the public.

**SECTION 3. Severability.**

If any portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4. Repealer.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 5. Effective Date.**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication in accordance with KRS 424.130, or as otherwise provided by law.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GLENCOE, GALLATIN COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2025 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2026 BY REAPPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE OPERATIONS OF CITY GOVERNMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, the Glencoe City Council has reviewed the Annual Budget for 2025 2026 and has made all necessary or advisable modifications, and approved said Budget estimating revenues and appropriating funds for the operations of the City government; and

**WHEREAS**, the Glencoe City Council has determined that the Budget for the Fiscal Year 2025-2026, attached as an Exhibit hereto be adopted by the City of Glencoe
