ORDINANCE NO. 08-26
 ORDINANCE SPECIAL PURPOSE VEHICLES

SUMMARY: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 22 – TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES, ADDING A NEW ARTICLE VI – STREET-LEGAL SPECIAL PURPOSE VEHICLES, RELATING TO THE AUTHORIZATION FOR STREET-LEGAL SPECIAL PURPOSE VEHICLES TO BE OPERATED ON THE CITY HIGHWAYS PURSUANT TO KRS CHAPTER 186.077, et al

WHEREAS, KRS 186.077 through 186.078 allows for the operation of street-legal special purpose vehicles on certain highways within the Commonwealth of Kentucky if allowed by ordinance of the local government within whose jurisdictional boundaries the highway is located; and

WHEREAS, the City of Henderson acknowledges that special purpose vehicles rare owned by and operated by a number of its residents, and there is benefit to the residents being able to utilize special purpose vehicles to travel on the roads of the City of Henderson; and

WHEREAS, the City of Henderson believes that setting specific safety and operation guidelines to ensure the special purposes vehicles are street-legal as required by the law which is important for the safety of residents who choose to operate special purpose vehicles within the county and for other motorists on the roadways for the City of Henderson and

WHEREAS, by the authority in KRS 186.078, the City has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to adopt this ordinance to expressly allow the operation of street-legal special purpose vehicles on the highway within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City of Henderson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Henderson, Kentucky, that new Article VI. of Chapter 22 of the Code of Ordinances shall be created and Article VI entitled "Street-Legal Special Purpose Vehicles", shall read in its entirety as follows:

ARTICLE VI. – STREET-LEGAL SPECIAL PURPOSE VEHICLES

SECTION 22-163 - Definition

a. "Street - Legal Special Purpose Vehicle" shall have the same meaning as defined set forth in K.R.S. 186.077, and as may be amended in the future by the Kentucky General Assembly, are adopted and incorporated by reference as if set forth fully herein.

b. "Highway" shall have the same meaning as defined in KRS 186.010(2)

SECTION 22-164 - Designated Highways

Street-legal special purpose vehicles shall be allowed on the highways as defined in KRS 186.010(2), or portions thereof, that are located within the jurisdictional limits of City of Henderson where the speed limit is 45 miles per hour or less. authorization shall not extend to highways in incorporated portions of the County.

SECTION 22-165 - Exceptions

Street-legal special purpose vehicles shall not be allowed to operate:

(a) On any highway or portion thereof, located within the jurisdictional limits of the City of Henderson, Kentucky unless allowed by this ordinance;

(b) On any highway, or portion thereof, that is a controlled access system, including but not limited to an interstate or parkway; or

(c) On any highway, or portion thereof, where the United States Department of Agriculture prohibits special purpose vehicles.

SECTION 22-166 - Prohibitions

(a) Street-legal special purpose vehicles are prohibited from traveling a distance greater than twenty (20) miles on a highway displaying centerline pavement markings.

(b) Minitrucks shall not be operated as street-legal special purpose vehicles on a highway that has been constructed pursuant to a federal highway program.

SECTION 22-167 - Operation Requirements

Before any owner of a street-legal special purpose vehicle, as defined by KRS 186.077, may operate or permit its operation upon a highway, the street-legal special purpose vehicle shall:

(a) be equipped with all of the required safety equipment in K.R.S. 186.077(1)(c)(1);

(b) be registered with the County Clerk's Office in accordance with K.R.S. 186.020;

(c) display the registration plate issued by the County Clerk's Office;

(d) be insured by the owner or the operator for the payment of tort liabilities in the same form and amounts as set forth in KRS 304-39-110 for motorcycles;

(e) any operator or passenger of a street-legal special purpose vehicle under the age of eighteen (18) shall wear a protective helmet at all times the vehicle is being operated within the City limits; and

(f) comply with all other requirements of the Act and of this Ordinance.

This ordinance shall become effective upon legal adoption.

 ORDINANCE AMENDING BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

SUMMARY: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 2025 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2026 FOR THE CITY OF HENDERSON, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2025, the City of Henderson adopted its annual budget and appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026, being Ordinance No. 23-25, and,

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2026, the City of Henderson amended its annual budget and appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026, being Ordinance No. 04-26, and,

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends that the following additional amendments be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Henderson, Kentucky, that Ordinance No. 04-26 is amended as follows:

1. The budget submitted to the Board of Commissioners by the City Manager is hereby adopted and approved and said budget is incorporated herein by reference, and three copies thereof, signed by the Mayor, shall be kept on file in the office of the City Clerk as part of the public record of the City.

2. There is hereby appropriated from the General and Special Fund Accounts of the City of Henderson and allocated to the various Funds of the City the following amounts:

3. The number and classifications of City employees as recited in the Annual Budget is approved as presented.

4. The City Manager is authorized to hire an additional two (2) police officers when it is deemed necessary by the Chief of Police and the City Manager due to the length of training necessary for this position.

5. The City Manager is authorized to hire an additional one (1) firefighter when it is deemed necessary by the Fire Chief and the City Manager due to the length of training necessary for this position.

6. The City Manager is authorized to hire additional non-hazardous duty personnel for key positions when deemed necessary for succession training purposes and the expenditures for the additional hires do not exceed the appropriations granted.

7. This Ordinance shall be effective as of July 1, 2025.
